OUR SCHOOL

ILC Preschool is a Christian school offering classes for young children. We are a ministry that helps children develop, spiritually, physically, socially and emotionally in preparation for continuing education. We encourage the development of self-discipline, a good self image, curiosity and enthusiasm for learning. We feel that the education of children requires cooperation and communication between the school and family.

PRESCHOOL CLASSES

Our Preschool program accepts children ages three through five. However, your child must turn three on or before August 31st and be completely toilet trained for our three day/week program and age four on or before August 31 to be eligible for our kindergarten ready programs. All of our classes accept ongoing registration throughout the year. Our program starts in September and runs through the second week in June.

Class Sessions and times are as follow:

Our class size is limited to 10 students in the 2 yr. old class, 14 students in the three days a week program and 16 students in our kindergarten ready programs. All classrooms have a teacher and a full time classroom assistant. Our professional staff is carefully selected based on their educational background, classroom training, teaching experience and sensitivity to the individual needs of young children. All of our staff members hold a current certification in CPR. Class placement is at the discretion of the Preschool Director and Staff.

TUITION & FEES


The following items are required at the time of registration:

- **Completed Registration Packet**-available online at www.ilcpuyallup.org. New families can use the online registration process, just follow the link through our website-under preschool.
- Current Immunization Records- Can be faxed in advance to 253-848-3147
- Non-Refundable Registration Fee-\$100.00
- Supply/Activity Fee-\$125.00

If you are a currently enrolled family you will have the option to break your registration fees into two installments, that will be deducted by auto pay using a current checking account or a credit card. This option is only extended to our currently enrolled families at this time. All tuition payments are made through EFT services from a checking/ savings or credit card account in ten(IO) equal monthly payments. If you would like to prepay tuition in full for the year you will receive a 5% discount. There is a 5% discount for multiple children from the same family on your second/lower tuition child. Registration & Supply/Activity fees are not discounted.

Tuition cost:

- 2 yr. old program \$800.00 per year (Oct-May) or \$100.00/M
- 3 day program \$2250.00 per year or \$225.00/M
- 4 day program \$2750..00 per year or \$275.00/M



CAMPUS TOURS

In order to maintain a safe and uninterrupted environment, tours are by appointment only and limited to one adult. After a child is enrolled parents may schedule an appointment to view the school after normal school hours. Due to current health and safety procedures a mask and temperature check will be preformed prior to any visit. Email us at preschool@ilcpuyallup.org to request a visit.

ENROLLMENT

Enrollment for our current school year is ongoing if we have space available. All fees will be prorated at the time of enrollment. You can find registration paperwork or register online at www.ilcpuyallup.org under the preschool tab. We conduct a three phase registration based on a first come first served basis.

Phase I: Priority enrollment: Currently enrolled families.

• Phase 2: Active church members and/or ANY preschool alumni . By our definition an alumni family is any family that has been enrolled in our program, regardless of the time between enrolled children.



• Phase 3: New students/families can submit paperwork online anytime after January 15th, however your registration packet will not generate new enrollment status until priority/alumni registration dates have passed and all paperwork/fees are submitted. Watch our website for registration dates.
